Rachel Taylor, County Clerk, confirmed the CART mileage for Sheridan and Jefferson Township was updated with the latest road updates. The clerk's office will continue to check the other townships to see if any corrections need to be made.

BRIDGES:

The Commission reviewed BRO 002 Supplemental Agreement #1. David Cox made a motion to accept the agreement, and Wayne Uthe seconded the motion. 3 – Aye, 0 – No. Motion passed.

The Commission signed a MoDOT on-call consultant letter for BRO 003 and BRO 004.

NEW BUSINESS:

David Cox attended the Ameren local public hearing in Milan on April 22nd, for the PSC state authority to build 200 miles of electric line through Daviess County.

The Commission spoke with Attorney Travis Elliot to clarify final details for SB190, in future will be known as the Daviess County Senior Tax Credit Freeze. The Commission plans to pass the ordinance next Wednesday.
