James Boehm, resident of Liberty Township, met with the Commission to discuss his concerns regarding maintenance on a portion of Nicle Avenue. The Commission spoke with Liberty Township to confirm routine maintenance is being done on Nickle Avenue and this portion of the road is neither abandoned nor closed.

In the afternoon the Commissioners inspected roads, culverts, bridges, and brush in Grand River, Liberty, and Monroe Townships.

Rachel Taylor, County Clerk, informed the Commission that a recycling pick-up has been scheduled for all broken and nonworking electronic equipment. The County Clerk's office has also scheduled a shred truck to onsite shred documents in June. The Clerk's office is shredding all warrants and invoices that are beyond the required retention dates.
