Mike Noe, Grand River Mutual, met with the Commission to talk about a fiber installation project they will be starting soon in Jamesport. No further action is required at this time.

Jay Ashcroft, Secretary of State, stopped by the County Clerk's office to visit about the upcoming election and to offer his and the Secretary of State's office's support to the County Clerk's office. He stopped at the Commission meeting to say hello and chat about Daviess County.
