

Minutes of the Daviess County Commission
April 15, 2026

The Honorable Daviess County Commission met on Wednesday, April 15, 2026, at 8:00 a.m. Jim Ruse, Presiding Commissioner, called the meeting to order. David Cox, 1st District, and Wayne Uthe, 2nd District, are present.

The Commission approved last week's minutes and invoices. The Commission approved brush letters and abates if presented.

James Lewis, Road and Bridge Supervisor, updated the Commission that the crew replaced boards on the bridge on Forest Avenue in Grand River Township. The Commission asked James to look at the easement of the westside driveway at the Daviess County Nursing and Rehab.

OLD BUSINESS:

Grand River HVAC completed the installation of a mini-split unit in the Judge's third-floor office. This project has been concluded until the next phase.

A new security system has been approved. Corwin Electric has been notified of the electricity requirements.

Rebecca with Green Hills, David Roll, EMA, Tanner Hunter, and Billie Hunter, KAW Fire Department, met with the Commission to discuss the possibility of a CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) opportunity through Green Hills. KAW Fire Department presented the Commission with their proposal. David Cox made a motion for the County to be the fiscal agent if KAW received the grant funds. Wayne Uthe seconded the motion. All in favor; Ruse-aye, Cox-aye, Uthe-aye. Motion carried 3-0. This is the beginning stages of the grant, and KAW will continue to work through the steps for the grant application.
